Fady Hannah-Shmouni, MD, FRCPC, is a Canadian endocrinologist and biochemical geneticist specializing in precision medicine, genomics, and agentic AI technologies. He serves as Medical Advisor to Science & Humans, Assistant Clinical Professor at the University of British Columbia, and Founder & CEO of Hormonaly.ai, a clinical AI platform for peptide, hormone, and longevity medicine. Previously, he led adrenal and growth hormone research at the National Institutes of Health (NIH), where he served as Principal Investigator and Associate Program Director of the Endocrinology Fellowship Program.

He has authored more than 100 peer-reviewed publications and the book *Familial Endocrine Cancer Syndromes*, and was Founding Editor-in-Chief of *Endocrine and Metabolic Science* (Elsevier). His honours include the NIH NICHD Mentor Award, two Endocrine Society Outstanding Abstract Awards, and the Joe T.R. Clarke Award for excellence in teaching.

Dr. Hannah-Shmouni earned his MD from the University of Jordan, completed Internal Medicine residency at Yale, and fellowships in Endocrinology & Metabolism (NIH) and Clinical Biochemical Genetics (University of Toronto).
