Upon moving away from life as a public school educator, he went with Africa New Life to build Keyhole Gardens in Kageyo, Rwanda. While on the trip, his group saw a water shortage in the town of Kageyo. They decided upon returning they would start a water well project, quickly learning how and returning to transition their idea to reality. It was in that opportunity that Jeff realized he wanted to travel the world, help people, and get paid to do it. Jeff knew he wanted to blog about traveling. It was then that he found, or rather didn't find, fat Black men represented. With that, Chubby Diaries was born. Since starting Chubby Diaries in 2017, Jeff has added a podcast, Chubby Diaries Annual Travel Awards, and most recently a campaign to give people in his community financial access to passports.
