Instructions

There are two types of updates:

1. Minor—Where changes are made to a small section of the text, changes are indicated in **bold**.
2. Major—Entire sections are provided as a replacement.

Textbook, Chapter 1

Page 20, iv. Multi-employer Plans, last sentence of the third paragraph: Delete “however, a legislative modification following a recent legal case confirms Québec as an exception to this rule.”

Note that 2015 changes to Québec’s *Supplemental Pensions Act* eliminated this exception.

Textbook, Chapter 9

Page 261, b. Registration Requirements and Applicable laws: Paragraphs two through five describe the evolution of the CAPSA “Agreement Respecting Multi-Jurisdictional Pension Plans” (MJPP Agreement) from the time of the 1968 Memorandum of Reciprocal Agreement.

Note that as of July 1, 2023, the MJPP has been adopted by all Canadian jurisdictions, including the federal government.

These four paragraphs describing the evolution of the agreement are NOT testable material for the purpose of the CEBS examination.
